- Responsible for following laboratory procedures and schedules for specimen handling and processing, test performance, analyses, and reporting and maintaining records of patient test results as well as all safety and compliance regulations;
- Adhere to the laboratory's quality control policies, document all quality control activities, instrument and procedural calibrations and maintenance performed;
- Be capable of identifying problems and exceptions that may adversely affect test performance or reporting of test results and document all corrective actions taken when test systems deviate from the laboratory's established performance specifications. Assist with Laboratory Process Improvement activities in support of overall lab improvement;
- Assay scheduling, Documentation creation and revision.

Qualifications:

- Bachelor or Masters' degree in biological science or other related discipline required; Histology experience required;
- Working knowledge of routine histological staining methods is preferred;
- Ability to perform microtome sectioning of FFPE tissue is essential;
- 1-4 years' experience in a clinical laboratory setting performing CLIA high complexity testing (CAP accredited laboratory experience a plus);
